Behavioral Home Energy Reports must be delivered to end-use residential customers on a quarterly cadence, at a minimum. The reports must be paper reports. Digital reports do not meet BPA's requirements. Third party evaluations must show that average energy savings averages no less than 404 kWh per household per year. Note: additional requirements apply, per the BPA Implementation Manual.
